3. Include three signed recommendation letters, one which is from someone not associated with the school system (employer, community service organization or non-profit organization).
4. Include a 500 word essay on your primary goals after high school graduation and why you set these goals for yourself.
5. Return the completed scholarship application form and support materials to your guidance counselor.
